## DISCUSSION POINT ONE: WHAT A STRANGE IDEA!

What must the disciples have thought?

First, in Mark 8:27-30 what was the point of Jesus" question?

What was the difference between who people thought He was, and His true identity?

Second, following Peter's statement in v 29, imagine the reaction to what Jesus says in v 31.

# • <u>DISCUSSION POINT TWO: WHAT PROPHECIES FORETOLD THAT MESSIAH WAS DEITY, AND THAT HE HAD TO DIE?.</u>

Read Isaiah 9:6 and 41:22-24. Who was the Redeemer to be?

And now read Isa. 52:13-53:12!

Interesting item: In Isa. 53:9 the Jews intended for Jesus to be dumped into a criminals' burial place, BUT, what does the next phrase say? "and with ...." with whom? Note the important article "a" before the words "rich man". Who was that? (Matt. 27:57; Mark 15:43; Luke 23:51; John 19:38)

Think about the <u>specific</u> prophecy, given over 700 years earlier, that was fulfilled here!

### • DISCUSSION POINT THREE: JUST HOW EXTENSIVE IS GOD'S LOVE?

Look at God's self description in Exodus 34:6-7a.

Now consider the truth of the rest of verse 7.

Who is guilty? Look at Isa. 53:6. Note God's stated solution.

Was God just <u>nice</u> to us, or was this the most mind-boggling act of LOVE imaginable?

**Discuss 1 John 4:7-11.** 

### CHALLENGE: WHAT RESPONSE DOES GOD'S LOVE REQUIRE OF ME?

What about the first Believers? Look at Mark 8:34-38.

What about me, today?

What does it communicate if I become complacent and just live for myself? After all, life is a complicated, right?
