DISCUSSION POINT ONE: WHY???

Have you ever stopped to ponder the following?

Why did God create - create anything?

Why did God create humans?

Why did God allow sin to exist? Why not destroy Lucifer instantly?

Why did God plan to die?

Apart from His perfect holiness, what is the primary characteristic of God? (See Exodus 34:6-7)

How could God ever express His love?

How much damage did our rebellion against God's authority create?

Consider Romans 8:19-22.

So – we can not fix it. How did that define what kind of a Redeemer was required?

Look at Romans 8 again. Did only mankind need fixing?

When did God decide to suffer in order to redeem His creation?

Check 1 Peter 1:17-25.

How did this require God to become one of His own creatures – in the person of the man Jesus?

What did Jesus' death really accomplish?

Why is His resurrection so important?

What was God's purpose. Was it just to save me? Look at 1 John 3:4-10. Compare the last part of verse 8 with Galatians 1:4.

How does the concept of Grace fit into this discussion?

OK. Now. What <u>is</u> the essence of the Gospel?

Look at Paul's words to the Galatians in Acts 13:38-43. What is the last phrase in that passage?

Compare that to Gal. 1:6. What is meant by "grace"?

How does that affect my response to the Gospel?

As a Jew, the Law was important. To us who were Gentiles, how important was (is) it to earn, to deserve, what we get? Or at least to get what we think we deserve?

How can I ever be good enough to be accepted by God?

(REALLY!? "Your credit is no good here!")

Regarding OUR debt – review Colossians 2:12-14.

Now add verse 15.
