#### **KEY TRUTHS:**

### • <u>DISCUSSION POINT ONE: THANKSGIVING HOME DINNERS vs. EATING</u> AT A RESTAURANT.

Is there anything wrong with expecting to be served at church, rather than being those who serve?

Look at 1 Cor. 12:7 and 12:14-27.

What are the key ideas in these verses?

How would you apply these in your life?

Read Ephesians 4:11-16.

Now re-read v. 12 – Why were apostles, evangelists, prophets, shepherds and teachers given to the church?

Who is to be prepared for the work of God?

Discuss the picture here of what the church is to be like. What is the role of love in all this?

### DISCUSSION POINT TWO: HOW CAN I KNOW WHAT MY GIFT IS?

Do you yourself really have a grace-gift?

Look again at Eph. 4:7-8 and 1 Cor. 12:7. What do these verses make very clear?

What gifts are described in the Word? Look at the verses and listings in the hand-out that was sent at the same time as these notes.

Discuss how you can discover your gift.

### **Persecuted Believers:**

Let's not forget to uphold our fellow believers around the world who are experiencing real and intense persecution for following Jesus.

### THIS WEEK:

### 1. India:

Hindu extremists attacked believers at a Christian peace festival on Feb. 24 in New Delhi, injuring many.

The extremists used iron rods, sticks and axes to destroy most of the electronic equipment before working their way into the crowd.

Although the organizers had received approval for police protection, no police arrived until after the Hindu extremists had fled.

Please pray for those who were injured and also for those who attacked these believers. Pray for wisdom among the Christians who are considering legal action.

### 2. Malaysia:

Pastor Raymond Koh, a highly effective evangelist, was abducted on Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>.

Despite offering a large reward, no one has come forward with information and no ransom demands have been made. The family therefore fear that the pastor has been murdered.

Pray for his wife and family, as well as for his welfare and release if still alive.

### 3. Nigeria:

A group of Fulani men attacked a village recently in Kaduna, Nigeria, killing four people and injuring two adults and a young child.

A woman named Lydia suffered gunshot wounds to her back, right arm and abdomen, while one-year-old Confidence was struck in both feet and on her hip. Williams Aluwong Jonathan, his wife and their 3-month-old baby were outside their home when the Fulani began shooting. His wife was shot to death as she ran for the house with their baby. Williams was shot 15 times in the arm but was able to protect their baby from harm.

Please pray for these folks, thanking God that they survived and also for quick healing physically, emotionally and spiritually.
